Be Content

'Give us this day our daily bread' answers the question of our need for **dependence**.

Yes, Father, you sustain and guide and provide all of my needs for my entire life.

Confess Weakness

'Lead us not into temptation' answers the question of our true **human condition**.

Yes, Father, by your power I say 'No' to sin as you mature my faith through testing.

Admit Failure

'Forgive us our sins' answers the question of and the quest for ultimate **perfection**.

Yes, Father, I receive and live in the freedom of total forgiveness through Jesus.

Show Mercy

'As we forgive those who sin against us' answers the question of my **relationships**.

Yes, Father, I give up grudges and bitterness to extend mercy to all who offend me.

Live Hopefully:

'Deliver us from the Evil One' answers the question of the certainty of my **future**.
