## Christian identity is more about WE than ME.

Identity! The church is built on the rock of **revelation** that Peter confessed.

Matthew 16:16-18

Ministry! Through the church, Jesus ministers his redeeming reconciliation.

Matthew 18:17

- **A. The Church People:** Jesus said: 'I will build my church (ekklesia) = people, Stephen called Israel 'the assembly (ekklesia) in the wilderness' (Acts 7:38).
- B. The Church Pardoned: 'church of God which he bought with his own blood.' (Acts 20:28). The cross is our verdict on Jesus. The cross is God's verdict on sin. The Son of Man came....to give his life as a ransom for many.' (Mark 10:44-45).

## C. The Church - Purpose: 1 Timothy 3:14-15

Although I hope to come to you soon I am writing you these instructions so that if I am delayed you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household which is the church of the living God...pillar and foundation of the truth.

The Church is the pillar and foundation of the truth. Not 'tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine by the trickery of people, by craftiness in deceitful scheming.' (Eph 4:14) We are also the foundation of the truth. We hold the truth firm against all heresy. We hold the truth up making it visible. Christian truth is public truth. 'It was not done in a corner!' (Acts 26:26) Christian truth is total truth encompassing all of creation and history and eternity. What is truth?

Truth in a first century hymn.

Beyond all question the mystery from which true godliness springs is great: He appeared in the flesh, he was vindicated by the Spirit, he was seen by angels, He was preached among nations, was believed on in world, he was taken up glory.

- 1. 'He' Personal Jesus. The True God. Deity. True man. Humanity in word and deed.
- 2. History: 'appeared' Body: birth. Spirit: baptism ministry. Angels: resurrection. Nations: preached to all the world. Believed: on in the world. Glory: taken up.
- 3. Eternity: 1. Flesh and Spirit: The Work of Jesus Human and Divine in Palestine.
  - 2. **Angels and Nations**: The Witness of Jesus to heaven and on earth.
  - 3. **Believed and Glory:** The Welcome of Jesus as he acclaimed as Lord.

    This truth is worth living for and worth dying for.
