The man ready to die for Jesus can tell us how to live for Jesus.

The church is not a religious community of worshippers of Christ but is Christ himself who has taken form among his people.

'lurge you I tell You I insist'

'Live a life worthy of the calling you have received.'
The calling to be unified (1:4; 9-11).

'There is one body and one Spirit' (4:4;25) We are the limbs of Jesus. God's cosmic 'oneness' purpose (1:9-10) is done through the church (2:11-13; 3:6). This is the 'glory in the church' that Paul prayed for (3:21)

We are to answer Jesus' prayer:

1 have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—1 (John 17:22-23).

<u>Be completely</u> humble, gentle; patient, bearing with one another in love...kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other as in Christ God forgave you.

4:7-10

Psalm 68 God fought for his people so that they could live in the promised land. Jesus went to the cross to save the Church. He ascended so we can be the church.

4:11-14

The unity we keep is the unity we seek. The goal is becoming God's mature body. We are all ministers. We need a biblical education to be equipped and fully trained.

4:15-16	Resisting error. Speaking truth in love. Living the truth.
4:17-19	Remember what we were!
4:20-24	Remember what Christ taught!
4:25-32	Goodbye to godlessness.
	Welcome to God's family.

Cease moving into yourself and away from others.

Give up your antagonism. God moved toward you in gracious,
outgoing love, and you must move toward others in that same outgoing love.
