Men (untrained) from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also, telling them (everyday conversation) the good news about the Lord Jesus.' (Acts 11:19-20)

Antioch 3rd largest city in Roman Empire.

Large numbers 'believed and turned
to the Lord...' (Acts 11:21,24,26)

Believed – Trusted – Relied Turned – Repented – Changed

Trained – Taught – Mentored Barnabas and Saul

Disciples called Christians at Antioch.

Jesus acted contrary to culture. Jesus chose his own disciples.
