'Grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus' (3:18).

A. <u>Divine Resources</u>: Precious faith Abundant grace Great Promises Divine Power (1:1,3) (1:2-4)

B. Human Responsibility:'make every effort to add to your faith' (1:5)'effort' (choregos) means 'leader of a chorus.'Actively pursue righteousness.'add' doesn't mean add faith! 'Add to...'Furnish your life with virtue.

Six virtues framed by faith (1:5) and consummated by love (1:7).

Goodness pictures land which is fertile, or an upstanding citizen (1 Peter 2:12).

Knowledge means the ability to apply heavenly wisdom to life so as to act honorably.

Self-control means saying 'No' to sin and to sinful desires. Self-control involves a fight!

Perseverance is courageous, voluntary, daily suffering of hard things for God's honor.

Godliness means worshipping God and serving Man – having your Father's likeness.

Brotherly Kindness: Ancient cities were full of *'squalor, misery, illness, and anonymity'* In the early church people saw the reality of family and evidence of a caring community.

C. Eternal Reward: Don't be barren: An ineffective and unproductive life. 1:8 Don't be blind: Never forget you've been forgiven. 1:9

'Therefore, brothers and sisters, make every effort to confirm your calling and election. For *if you <u>do these</u> things*, you will never stumble' (2 Peter 1:10).

What things?

a. Make every effort to *add to your faith*.

b. Confirm your calling and election (1:5;10)

Stumble? A Christian might trip but the trajectory of their life is upward not downward. *'you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus'* 2 Peter 1:11

God will give a *lavish* welcome to all who gladly wear his character.
