NSBC Sermon Notes 2 Peter 1:16-21 September 4, 2022

What the Bible mean to you?

GUARD 'take care not [to be] carried away with the error of lawless people' (3;17)

GROW 'grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus.' (3:18)

'knowledge' of Jesus in the Scriptures.

'the prophetic word...you will do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your heart' (1 Peter 1:20-21).

<u>2 Peter 1:16-18 Pay Attention!</u> The Bible is Historically Trustworthy

'We did not follow cleverly devised myths.'

James, John, Peter were eyewitnesses.

The Bible is **Dated - Located - Public**'not done in a corner' (Acts 26:26).

2 Peter 1:20-21 Pay Attention! The Bible Has Authority

'no prophecy came by prophet's own interpretation but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.'

Jesus promised the **Holy Spirit** 'will guide you into all the truth.' (John 16:12,14)
Bible writers were compelled ('driven' Acts 27:15) to write. 'Christ recognizes in
Scripture nothing less than the infallible record of the revelation of His heavenly
Father; He decides according to its statutes and directs His steps where it points.

2 Peter 1:19 Pay attention. The Bible Explains Reality

'we have the prophetic word... a lamp shining in a dark place.'

God's Word is like 'a lamp'. Darkness is a moral metaphor. 'People loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.' (John 3:19-20) When Judas betrayed Jesus at night!' (Jn 13:30) Jesus was arrested 'when darkness reigns.' (Luke 22:53) Darkness is 'a stronghold where Satan establishes to exalt himself against the knowledge and plans of God. A stronghold repels light and exports darkness.'

Jesus is 'the bright Morning Star' (Rev 22: 16).

Are you a Morning person?

The degree to which you look forward to Jesus' return will be is reflected in the way you read and obey the Bible.
